ACCORDING TO TASS, PRAVDA SAID THAT "IN RECENT DAYS SOVIET REPRESENTATIVES REPEATEDLY URGED CZECHOSLOVAK COMRADES (AT THE AIRPORT) TO RESUME WORK."

"THE 6,000 STRONG STAFF OF THE AIRPORT," PRAVDA CONTINUED, "IS KEPT IDLE AND GETS NO RPT NOT PAY."

"THE STATE IS SUSTAINING GREAT LOSSES WHILE J. KARLIK, DIRECTOR OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK AIRLINES, AND A. PAZNOCHT, THE AIRPORT CHIEF, EVADE ANY SERIOUS TALK. THE AIRPORT LEADERS TOOK A PARTICULARLY UNSEEMLY STAND WITH REGARD TO THE CARRIAGE OF CZECH CHILDREN WHO ARRIVED AT THE AIRPORT BY AEROFLOT PLANES FROM THE SOVIET UNION WHERE THEY STAYED FOR SUMMER HOLIDAYS."

"THE AIRPORT LEADERS FORBADE THE STAFF NOT RPT NOT ONLY TO SERVICE THE AEROFLOT PLANES BUT ALSO APPROACH THEM THE CHILDREN WERE RECEIVED BY SOVIET SOLDIERS AND THE MILITARY COMMAND PROVIDED BUSES TO TAKE THEM HOME."

"ALL THIS IS A CONTINUATION OF THE LINE OF THOSE HOSTILE FORCES WHICH HAVE NOT RPT NOT ABANDONED THEIR SINISTER AND ANTINATIONAL DESIGNS."
