

X/4 C/S -- "PRAGUE IS A SAD AND BRAVE CITY"

MUNICH, AUG. 31 (CMD) -- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID TODAY THAT PRAGUE WAS NOW "A SAD AND A BRAVE CITY."

"SAD," THE RADIO SAID, "BECAUSE THE PEOPLE ARE NOT RPT NOT TALKING LOUDLY WITH EACH OTHER AND HARDLY ANYONE IS SMILING IN THE STREETS, AND BRAVE BECAUSE IT HAS MANAGED TO UNDERSTAND THE SITUATION."

THE RADIO COMPLAINED THAT ITS STAFF WAS STILL NOT RPT NOT BEING ALLOWED BACK INTO ITS FORMER HEADQUARTERS IN PRAGUE.

IT ALSO SAID THE NUMBER OF "ILLEGAL" STATIONS, SIMILAR TO THE SOVIET-SUPPORTED VLTAVA STATION, WAS INCREASING.

THE BROADCAST SAID:

"THE ILLEGAL RADIO STATIONS THAT ARE OPERATING ON OUR TERRITORY IN A STILL INCREASING IN NUMBER, SUCH AS, FOR EXAMPLE, ZARE, THE WORKER'S VOICE OF THE REPUBLIC, OR VLTAVA AND WHICH SAY, INDEED, THAT THE PRAGUE COUNTER-REVOLTUION DOES NOT RPT NOT SLEEP, THAT IT BACKS JANUARY AND OPPOSES NOVOTNY; BUT IN SPITE OF THIS THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IS HEARD IN THE PRAGUE STREETS AND THE PEOPLE ARE CALM, AND IT IS NOT RPT NOT NECESSARY TO TELL THEM ANYTHING."

"EVEN PRAGUE RESIDENTS KNOW THAT THERE ARE FRIENDS WHO WANT TO FIND A PRETEXT FOR A COUNTER-REVOLTUION AT ANY PRICE AND THAT IT IS NECESSARY TO DO EVERYTHING THAT CALM AND ORDER BE IN THE CAPITAL," THE RADIO SAID.
