ZEMEDESILKO ZNAME THEN ADDED: "IF FOR THEM THE MISFORTUNE OF THE BULGARIAN PRESS CONSISTS IN ITS BEING AN ABSOLUTE AND UNCOMPROMISING DEFENDER OF THE HISTORIC INTERNATIONAL MISSION OF THE FIVE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC, IF WE ARE UNFORTUNATE BECAUSE WE EXPRESS OUR OPINION AND SENTIMENTS IN COMPLETE HARMONY WITH THE PRESS OF THE U.S.S.R., POLAND, HUNGARY, AND THE G.D. R.... THEN WE READILY ACCEPT THE BURDEN OF SUCH A MISFORTUNE.

"IF THE MISFORTUNE OF THE BULGARIAN PRESS CONSISTS IN THAT IT IS STAUNCHLY AND BOUNDLESSLY LOYAL TO FRIENDSHIP WITH THE SOVIET UNION, THE BULGARIAN JOURNALISTS, AS LONG AS THEY ENJOY THEIR PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL STRENGTH, WILL CARRY PROUDLY ON OUR SHOULDERS SUCH A MISFORTUNE," THE ARTICLE ADDED. RADIO BELGRADE SAID LAST NIGHT THAT THE EAST BERLIN DAILY, BERLINER ZEITUNG, YESTERDAY FOR THE SECOND TIME WITHIN A SHORT TIME "SHARPLY ATTACKED THE BONN CORRESPONDENT OF THE BELGRADE DAILY, POLITIAK, BOZIDAR DIKIC, ACCUSING HIM OF ENGAGING IN A CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION."

RADIO BELGRADE SAID DIKIC HAD WRITTEN TWO ARTICLES IN POLITIKA, WHICH SHOW "THE ROLE OF EAST GERMANY IN THE PREPARATION OF THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

"THE COMMENTARY OF THIS EAST GERMAN NEWSPAPER SHARPLY ATTACKS AND REPROACHES THE YUGOSLAV JOURNALIST BECAUSE HE CALLED THE SO-CALLED AID TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA AN INVASION, THUS JOINING - AS IS SAID - THE CHORUS OF HATRED FROM BONN," RADIO BELGRADE ADDED. (RADIO BELGRADE, DOMESTIC/M AUG 30 1930)
