X/4/9 - P -- TRYBUNA LUDU SAYS YUGOSLAV STAND ON CS ANTI-SOCIALIST

WARSAW, AUG 31 (CMD)-- THE POLISH COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU SHARPLY ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA'S STAND ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA TODAY, SAYING BELGRADES ATTITUDE WAS NOT RPT NOT ONE OF NON-ALIGNMENT BUT RATHER ONE "UNEQUIVOCALLY ENGAGED AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION, AGAINST SOCIALIST COUNTRIES."

THE TRYBUNA LUDU EDITORIAL, AS REPORTED BY PAP, CHARGED THAT YUGOSLAVIA'S STANCE HAD ENCOURAGED THE CZECHOSLOVAKS TO MOVE FORWARD ON THE ROAD THAT LED TO AN "IMPERILMENT OF THE FOUNDATIONS OF SOCIALISM

IT SAID THAT YUGOSLAV LEADERS, IN EFFECT, ENDORSED THE "IMPERIALIST STRATEGY OF SOFTENING UP SOCIALISM, THE STRATEGY OF PEACEFUL COUNTER-REVOLUTION AIMED AT A PRECIPITATED EROSION OF THE SOCIALIST FOUNDATIONS OF THE NATIONAL EXISTENCE OF THE CZECHS AND SLOVAKS."

TRYBUNA LUDU SAID YUGOSLAVIA HAD EQUATED THE WARSAW PACT INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WITH "BLOODY IMPERIALIST INTERVENTIONS."

"SUCH AN ASSESSMENT, WHICH IGNORES THE EXISTING FRONTS OF CLASS STRUGGLE, CAN BE HARDLY NAMED AS A COMMUNIST EVALUATION," THE PAPER ASSERTED.

TRYBUNA LUDU SAID NO RPT NO COUNTRY COULD PRETEND TO BE NON-ALIGNED IN THE GLOBAL STRUGGLE BETWEEN THE SOCIALIST AND CAPITALIST SYSTEMS.

"YUGOSLAVIA, AS IS COMMONLY KNOWN, DOES NOT RPT NOT BELONG TO THE SOCIALIST CAMP," THE PAPER SAID.
