X/4/9P--- CYRANKIEWICZ DEMANDS NO "NEW MUNICH" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA
(RELADS CN 107)

MUNICH, AUGUST 31 (CMD) -- POLISH PREMIER JOSEF CYRENKIEWICZ TOLD A RALLY IN WARSAW TODAY THAT A "NEW MUNICH" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WOULD ENDANGER OTHER EAST EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.

CYRANKIEWICZ WAS ADDRESSING A RALLY MARKING THE 29TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE NAZI INVASION OF POLAND ON SEPTEMBER 1, 1939. HIS SPEECH WAS CARRIED LIVE BY RADIO WARSAW.

CYRANKIEWICZ SAID THE SLOGAN: "NEVER ANOTHER SEPTEMBER" MEANT THAT THERE SHOULD BE NO CHANGE IN THE PRESENT ALIGNMENT OF POWER IN EUROPE.

"THIS ALSO MEANS: NEVER ANOTHER MUNICH. A NEW MUNICH MEANS TODAY THE HUSKING OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA FROM THE DEFENCE SYSTEM OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES.

"THIS IS NOT THE AFFAIR OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC ALONE. THIS IS A MATTER OF MUTUAL TREATIES, INCLUDING THOSE WITH POLAND, WHICH ARE OBLIGATORY TODAY AND TOMMORROW; THIS IS A MATTER OF THE SECURITY OF ALL SOCIALIST STATES," SAID CYRANKIEWICZ.

"FOR US THIS IS A MATTER OF LAYING OPEN THE SOUTHERN FLANK. LOOK AT THE MAP. IT WOULD ALSO ENDANGER THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC AND HUNGARY, AND ALSO BULGARIA," HE SAID.

"THIS WOULD BE A THREAT TO THE WHOLE OF OUR SYSTEM OF SECURITY. OBVIOUSLY, IT WOULD ALSO BE A THREAT TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC ITSELF.

"THUS IT WOULD THREATEN A CHANGE IN THE ALIGNMENT OF FORCES IN EUROPE...A CHANGE DREAMED OF BY BONN MILITARISTS AND RAVANCHISTS LYING IN WAIT FOR THE SUDENTEN LAND, A CHANGE WORKED OUT IN THE ORGANISERS OF QUIET COUNTER-REVOLUTIONS AND THE SOFTENING OF SOCIALISM," HE SAID.
