

X/4 C/S -- C/S PEOPLE TO BE AWARE OF EVENTS EVEN UNDER CENSORSHIP

MUNICH, AUGUST 31 -- (CMD) -- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID TODAY IN A HUNGARIAN-LANGUAGE BROADCAST "WE KNOW AND WILL KNOW IN THE FUTURE WHERE WE STAND, EVEN IF ONE CANNOT RPT NOT SPEAK ABOUT THIS IN THE WAY WE WERE ACCUSTOMED TO IN THE PAST MONTHS".

THE RADIO SAID THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE "ALIEN TROOPS" ARE ONLY READY TO WITHDRAW MILITARY FORCES FROM TELECOMMUNICATION CENTRES IF THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION WILL NOT RPT NOT WRITE OR BROADCAST ARTICLES AND PROGRAMS "DIRECTED AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION, THE SOCIALIST CAMP AND THE WARSAW TREATY".

"IT IS TRUE THAT LAST WEEK OUR PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION USED NOT RPT NOT THE MOST PRESENTABLE WORDS AGAINST THE POLICY OF THE FIVE SIGNATORIES OF THE WARSAW LETTER, BUT THIS WAS A NATURAL REACTION AGAINST THEIR ILLEGAL MILITARY INTERVENTION", THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO SAID READERS AND LISTENERS WILL NOTICE THE CHANGE, BUT THIS WILL NOT RPT NOT MEAN "THAT WE WILL MAKE OUT WHITE FROM BLACK."

"OUR VIEW HAS NOT RPT NOT CHANGED CONCERNING THE EVENTS AND OUR COURAGE REMAINS, BUT WE UNDERSTOOD THAT WE HAVE TO KEEP AWAY FROM CRITICISM AND JUSTIFIED RESERVATIONS", THE RADIO SAID, AND ADDED:

"CONCERNING THE PRESENT SITUATION THERE IS NO RPT NO OTHER REALISTIC PROGRAM ONLY WHAT LEADING POLITICAL PERSONALITIES HAVE OUTLINED AND WE ARE TAKING FOR GRANTED THAT IT WILL BE SUCCESSFUL AND LEAD TO THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE FOREIGN TROOPS."
