

X/4 C/S - CSSR MUST SOLVE ITS OWN PROBLEMS, SAYS BUDAPEST

MUNICH, AUGUST 31 (CMD)- RADIO BUDAPEST SAID TODAY THAT THE FINAL SOLUTION TO CZECHOSLOVAK PROBLEMS HAD TO BE APPLIED BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK AUTHORITIES BECAUSE "THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT DID NOT, AND COULD NOT, PRODUCE A PRACTICAL SOLUTION."

THE RADIO SAID THE MOSCOW TALKS "ONLY OPENED THE POSSIBILITIES OF A SOLUTION, AND GUARANTEED FOR THE SOCIALIST FORCES THE SINCERE INTERNATIONALIST SUPPORT OF THE FRATERNAL COUNTRIES INCLUDING THE STATIONING OF ALLIED TROOPS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA UNTIL A SATISFACTORY SETTLEMENT OF THE SITUATION IS ACHIEVED."

IT SAID THAT THE USE OF PRACTICAL MEASURES SHOULD BE THE DUTY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK FORCES.

"A POLARIZATION PROCESS COULD BE OBSERVED THIS WEEK IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA. THE EXPLOITATION OF THE POSSIBILITIES GIVEN BY THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT HAS BEEN STARTED", THE RADIO SAID.

THE BROADCAST SAID THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAS MADE THEIR FIRST MEASURES "GUARANTEEING CONSOLIDATION."

IT SAID THAT THIS CONSOLIDATION WAS NOT (RPT NOT) LEFT UNDISTURBED BECAUSE DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN ENEMIES SOUGHT TO HINDER THE POLITICAL SETTLEMENT. (RADIO BUDAPEST DOMESTIC, M, AUG 31, 1445)
