XXX CYRANKIEWICZ

CYRANKIEWICZ SAID THAT "OUR BOYS, SONS, AND POSSIBLY ALSO GRANDSONS OF THE SOLDIERS..." WHO FOUGHT IN SEPTEMBER 1939 "ARE FINDING THEMSELVES ON PART OF THE TERRITORY OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC."

AFTER 29 YEARS SINCE SEPTEMBER 1939 "IF FELL TO THEM TO DEFEND OUR SOUTHERN FRONTIER BY THEIR PRESENCE.

"THUS, COMRADES, THE SLOGANS," NEVER ANOTHER SEPTEMBER" REQUIRES SOMETIMES, DIFFICULT DECISIONS, AND HARD ACTION."

CYRANKIEWICZ SAID THAT POLISH TROOPS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA "WERE OMPLEMENTING AN EXEMPLARY AND RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF GUARDING COMMON INTERESTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND POLAND; THE COMMON INTERESTS OF OUR WHOLE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY.

"WE DID NOT GO THERE, OBVIOUSLY, FOR EVEN FOR A SINGLE SQUARE METER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOIL; WE WENT TO DEFEND JOINTLY OUR COMMON SECURITY."

CYRANKIEWICZ CONCLUDED: "WE LOOK WITH CONFIDENCE INTO THE FUTURE BECAUSE WE HAVE THWARTED ON TIME, TO THE ANGER OF IMPERIALISM AND INTERNATIONAL REACTION, THE ACTION OF THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC SUPPORTED BY THEM (THAT IS BY IMPERIALISM AND INTERNATIONAL REACTION)."
