X/4 C/S - RADIO MOSCOW ATTACKS BELGRADE (W/ CN 147)

MUNICH, AUGUST 31 (CMD)- RADIO MOSCOW IN HUNGARIAN  
TODAY ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA'S POLICY CONCERNING CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE RADIO SAID THAT "AT THE TIME WHEN MANY  
COMMUNIST AND WORKER'S PARTIES APPROVE THE RESULT OF THE  
SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS, BELGRADE LAUNCHES FURTHER UNFAIR  
ATTACKS AGAINST THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES WHICH TOOK THE  
SIDE OF DEFENDING THE CAUSE OF SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO THEN SAID THAT BELGRADE'S BORBA IN DEALING WITH THE  
MOSCOW TALKS IS NOT RPT NOT SATISFIED WITH THE AGREEMENT.

"MAYBE THEY IN YUGOSLAVIA DO NOT RPT NOT WANT THE NORMALIZATION  
BUT THE SHARPENING OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA", THE  
RADIO SAID.

CONCERNING THE WEST GERMAN VIEWPOINT, THE RADIO  
SAID THAT BONN HAD ONLY ONE AIM, NAMELY "TO HINDER BY ALL  
MEANS THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THE MEASURES WORKED OUT AT  
THE MOSCOW TALKS."

"THE MAIN POINT OF THIS (BONN) POLICY IS CLEAR, NAMELY  
TO UNDERMINE SOCIALIST ORDER IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY FALSE  
PEACE SLOGANS AND TO BEGIN THE REVISION OF THE BORDERS  
ESTABLISHED AFTER WORLD WAR TWO", THE RADIO SAID. (RADIO MOSCOW
