RADIO EAST SLOVAKIA TODAY CALLED ON YOUNG PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF TREBISOV TO KEEP AWAY FROM A PLANNED MARCH THROUGH THAT TOWN TO A MEETING.

THE RADIO SAID THIS COULD BE CONSIDERED A DEMONSTRATION, AND THIS COULD RATHER COMPLICATE THE SITUATION OF SLOVAK REPRESENTATIVES AT A CONFERENCE WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FOREIGN ARMY. (RADIO EAST SLOVAKIA DOMESTIC/M, AUG 31, 1725)

RADIO NORTH BOHEMIA SAID THE STATIONING OF SOLDIERS OF THE WARSAW PACT IN THE NORTH BOHEMIAN REGION HAS SO FAR CAUSED DAMAGE AT 149.5 MILLION CROWNS.

THE RADIO SAID, ACCORDING TO A REPORT BY THE REGIONAL NATIONAL COUNCIL, ROADS HAVE BEEN PARTICULARLY DAMAGED.

"WE WOULD REALLY BETRAY THE NATION, IF WITH VOICE AND MICROPHONE WE WERE TO INSTIGATE THE PEOPLE'S MASSES TO RUN AGAINST GUNS,"
