

X/4 CURT - MAURER URGES UNITY OF COMMUNIST PARTIES

MUNICH, AUG. 31 (CMD)- RUMANIAN PREMIER ION GHEORGHE MAURER SAID TODAY THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND ITS CENTRAL COMMITTEE "WILL CONTINUE TO WORK FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE UNITY OF THE COMMUNIST PARTIES."

ACCORDING TO RADIO BUCHAREST, MAURER ADDRESSED A MEETING OF THE PARTY ACTIVE IN THE CENTRAL RUMANIAN TOWN OF SIBIU.

THE RADIO SAID "REFERRING TO PARTY AND GOVERNMENT POLICY ON INTERNATIONAL QUESTIONS, THAT MAURER HAD STRESSED THAT IT STEMMED FROM A REASONABLE BASICALLY MARXIST-LENINIST ANALYSIS OF EVENTS.

"THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND ITS CENTRAL COMMITTEE WILL IN FUTURE WORK IRRESISTIBLY FOR THE STRENGTHENING OF THE UNITY OF COMMUNIST PARTIES AND SOCIALIST STATES, A CAUSE WHICH CONSTITUTES A SIGNIFICANT FACTOR OF PROGRESS AND PEACE IN THE WORLD."

THE RADIO ALSO QUOTED MAURER AS SAYING THAT DURING HIS VISIT TO THE SIBIU REGION HE FOUND FIRM PROOF OF UNITY OF PEOPLE, PARTY AND LEADERSHIP, THAT IS A UNITY OF ALL NATIONALITIES, RUMANIANS, GERMANS, AND OTHERS, IN FAVOR OF A REALIZATION OF THE NOBLE IDEALS OF SOCIALISM AND RUMANIA'S PROSPERITY.

(CMD - SIBIU IS THE CENTRE OF THE GERMAN-LANGUAGE AREA OF RUMANIA.
