C/S -- PEKING MEETING CONDEMNS MOSCOW
(ATtribution RREQUIRED)

HONG KONG, SEPT. 1, REUTER - CROWDS OF CHINESE PEOPLE CONDEMNED THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AT A MEETING IN PEKING YESTERDAY TO MARK THE 23RD ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM, THE NEW CHINA NEWS AGENCY REPORTED TODAY.

A SENIOR PEKING OFFICIAL TOLD THE MEETING THE SOVIET LEADERS HAD ACTED JUST LIKE THE AMERICANS IN VIETNAM.

WU TEH, VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL REVOLUTIONARY COMMITTEE, ALSO SAID THE PRAGUE LEADERS -- "THE CZECHOSLOVAK REVISIONIST LEADING CLIQUE" -- HAS ADOPTED A CAPITULATIONIST POLICY OF NON-RESISTANCE.

FOREIGN MINISTER CHEN YI AND OTHER SENIOR GOVERNMENT AND ARMY OFFICIALS ATTENDED THE MEETING, THE AGENCY SAID.
