X/4 C/S - DANUBE: NO SATISFACTORY RESULTS IN TALKS WITH SOVIETS

MUNICH, SEPT 1 (CMD) - RADIO DANUBE SAID THIS MORNING THAT THERE HAD BEEN "NO RPT NO SATISFACTORY RESULTS" SO FAR IN THE TALKS BETWEEN CZECHOSLOVAK REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SOVIET COMMAND CONCERNING THE "VACATING OF RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS AS WELL AS THE NORMALIZATION OF ACTIVITY OF CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS IN SLOVAKIA."

THE RADIO ADDED THAT IT WOULD INFORM ITS LISTENERS AS SOON AS "THE FINAL RESULT IS REACHED AND THE BUILDINGS AND INSTALLATIONS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO AND TELEVISION ARE HANDED OVER TO OUR BODIES."

THE RADIO REPORTED THAT IT HAD RECEIVED THE INFORMATION ON THE TALKS WITH THE SOVIET COMMAND FROM THE BUREAU OF THE SLOVAK COMMISSIONER FOR CULTURE.

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT THE TALKS ON THE OPERATION OF THE BRATISLAVA MAIN POST OFFICE "ARE NOT RPT NOT SUCCESSFUL SO FAR."

THE RADIO SAID THAT ALTHOUGH EMPLOYEES WERE ABLE TO ENTER THE BUILDING AND START WORKING, "THE INTERCITY AND INTERSTATE TELEPHONE EXCHANGE IS STILL OCCUPIED."

RADIO DANUBE REPORTED THAT THE TELETYPE, TELEPHONE, SPECIAL PARCEL POST AND OTHER SERVICES WERE STILL NOT RPT NOT IN OPERATION.

REFERRING TO THE SITUATION IN KOSICE, EASTERN SLOVAKIA, THE RADIO SAID THAT THE NEWSPAPER OF THE SLOVAK PARTY COUNTY COMMITTEE HAD NOT RPT NOT COME OUT YESTERDAY "BECAUSE THE SOVIET MILITARY CENSORSHIP, WHICH HAD BANNED SEVERAL ARTICLES IN THE SAME DAILY THE DAY BEFORE, YESTERDAY STOPPED THE PRINTING MACHINE."
