

X/4 C/S - PAVLEND A OUTLINES RECOVERY MEASURES (W/CN - 2)

MUNICH, SEPT 1 (CMD) - VIKTOR PAVLEND A, SECRETARY OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, HAS OUTLINED A FOUR-PART PLAN AIMED AT RESTORATION OF NORMAL LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

ACCORDING TO RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN SLOVAK, PAVLEND A SAID LAST NIGHT THE PLAN HAD BEEN AGREED UPON AFTER TALKS WITH MEMBERS OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL, PARTY ECONOMIC SPECIALISTS, FACTORY HEADS AND WORKERS AT VARIOUS INSTITUTIONS.

PAVLEND A SAID THE PLAN INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING MEASURES:

"ONE -- IN ALL SECTORS OF ECONOMIC LIFE, IN PARTICULAR IN FACTORIES AND BUILDING SITES AND IN TRANSPORT, WE MUST SOLVE IMMEDIATELY THE PROBLEMS WHICH HAVE ARISEN BY THE PRESENCE OF WARSAW PACT TROOPS.

"TWO -- WE MUST NOT RPT NOT FORGET THE TASKS OF THE ECONOMIC YEAR 1968 AND THE PREPARATIONS FOR 1969. THE RELEVANT ORGANS OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL AND THE NATIONAL COMMITTEES MUST IMMEDIATELY (?START WORK ON THESE TASKS).

"THREE -- WE HAVE IMMEDIATELY RESUMED, AND THIS WAS DONE ALSO ON THE INITIATIVE OF OUR CZECH COMRADES, THE WORK ON THE FEDERATION THE PREPARATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL LAW, AND THE PREPARATION OF THE NEW STATUTES OF THE PARTY.

"FOUR -- WE HAVE SET UP A COORDINATION GROUP WHICH WILL STUDY AND SUBMIT ITS PROPOSALS AS TO THE FUTURE OF THE NEW SYSTEM OF MANAGEMENT WITH REGARD TO MEASURES NOW BEING PREPARED."

REGARDING THE TALKS THAT LED TO AGREEMENT ON THESE MEASURES, PAVELANDA SAID:

"ALL EMPHASIZED UNEQUIVOCALLY THEIR DETERMINATION TO DO EVERYTHING FOR DUBCEK'S CONCEPTION OF PRESERVING EVERYTHING THAT CAN BE PRESERVED. THEY EXPRESSED THE CONFIDENCE THAT ANY LOSSES SUSTAINED WILL BE MADE UP BY EXTRA SHIFTS, BRIGADES, AND SO FORTH. I AM CONVINCED THAT THE NATION-WIDE MOVEMENT FOR CONSOLIDATION WILL SOON BECOME WIDESPREAD, AND THAT THIS, TOO, WILL CONTRIBUTE TO A SPEEDY WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS."
