X/9 - CURT - TRYBUNA LUDU RIDICULES JOHNSON WARNING

WARSAW, SEPT. 1, REUTER - THE POLISH COMMUNIST PARTYS OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU TODAY DESCRIBED PRESIDENT JOHNSONS WARNING OF A POSSIBLE SOVIET INVASION THREAT TO RUMANIA AS "COMPLETELY FABRICATED NONSENSE."

THE NEWSPAPER, COMMENTING ON A SPEECH THE PRESIDENT MADE IN SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, LAST THURSDAY, SAID THE SOURCE OF HIS INFORMATION WOULD REMAIN "A DIRTY SECRET OF SOME PRESIDENTIAL ADVISERS AND PROMPTERS."

IT ADDED, "IT HAS NEVER HAPPENED BEFORE THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES DECLARED PUBLICLY AND AND WITH ALL SERIOUSNESS SUCH NONSENSICAL AND SLANDEROUS GOSSIP, CALCULATED TO STIR UP THE COLD WAR AND TO SOW DISTRUST."

U.S. POLICE GAVE THE LIE TO FINE PHRASES ABOUT DEFENDING THE RIGHTS OF SMALL NATIONS TO NATIONAL EXISTENCE. THE WASHINGTON LEADERS HAD NOT THE SLIGHTEST RIGHT TO GIVE OTHER NATIONS LESSONS IN MORALITY, TRYBUNA LUDU ADDED.
