CS - MALI LEADER PRAISES INVASION

BAMAKO, MALI SEPT 1 (UPI)-PRESIDENT MODIBO KEITA OF MALI TODAY SHARPLY CONDEMNED THE SECESSION OF BIAFRA FROM NIGERIA AND PRAISED THE WARSAW PACT MILITARY INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

AT A MEETING OF THE "NATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR DEFENSE OF THE REVOLUTION," MALI'S CABINET, KEITA REPORTED ON A MEETING WITH AN ENVOY OF THE NIGERIAN FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND CONDEMNED "ALL SECESSIONS IN AFRICA."

THE LEFT-WING PRESIDENT ALSO TERMED THE SOVIET INTERVENTION IN PRAGUE "PERFECTLY LEGITIMATE" AS A RESPONSE TO "INTERIOR REACTIONARIES CONNECTED WITH IMPERIALIST FORCES."
