

X/4 C/S -- RADIO DANUBE BECOMES RADIO BRATISLAVA

MUNICH, SEPT. 1 (CMD) -- RADIO DANUBE STARTED ITS 1400 MT BROADCAST TODAY AS RADIO DANUBE AND FINISHED IT AS RADIO BRATISLAVA.

THE ENSUING BROADCASTS OF THAT STATION WERE DESCRIBED AS BROADCASTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO BRATISLAVA.

AT 1403 MT THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE HOOK-UP PROGRAM OF CZECHOSLOVAK STATIONS READ: "WE ARE CALLING DANUBE. WE ARE CALLING DANUBE." THEN THE IDENTIFICATION SIGNAL OF RADIO DANUBE WAS HEARD, AND THE SPEAKER SAID: "THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO DANUBE SPEAKING."

AFTER SEVERAL PASSAGES OF A LITERARY PROGRAM, THE ANNOUNCER SAID: "YOU ARE LISTENING TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO BRATISLAVA."

THEN THE RADIO BROADCAST A PROGRAM IN HUNGARIAN, AND AGAIN THE ANNOUNCER SAID: "HERE IS THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO BRATISLAVA."

AFTER A BRIEF PROGRAM, DURING WHICH MESSAGES WERE READ FROM FAMILY MEMBERS, THE ANNOUNCER SAID: "THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO BRATISLAVA NOW GIVES THE MICROPHONE TO THE FRATERNAL RADIO PRAGUE."

RADIO BRATISLAVA ALSO SAID THAT IT WAS STILL BROADCASTING OUTSIDE OF ITS RADIO BUILDING.
