X/4 C/S - CERNIK AND CERNY DISCUSS TROOP WITHDRAWAL

MUNICH, SEPT. 1 (CMD) - CZECHOSLOVAK PREMIER OLDŘICH
CERNIK TODAY DISCUSSED WITH THE PRAGUE MAYOR LUDVIK CERNY THE CONDITIONS
LAID DOWN BY SOVIET TROOP COMMANDERS FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF OCCUPATION
FORCES FROM THE CITY.

THE SOVIET COMMAND HAS SAID THAT OCCUPATION TROOPS WILL NOT PULL
OUT UNTIL "UNSUITABLE INSCRIPTIONS" ARE REMOVED FROM THE CITY.
TODAY'S TALKS BETWEEN CERNIK AND CERNY, SAID RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA,
PRIMARILY CONCERNED "A SPEEDY REMOVAL OF UNSUITABLE INSCRIPTIONS."

THE BROADCAST SAID CERNIK WAS ACCOMPANIED BY VICE PREMIER
FRANTISEK HAMOUZ AND GENERAL MUCHA OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK ARMY.

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA MET CERNY
EARLY TODAY. CERNY INFORMED HIM ABOUT THE ACTIVITIES OF THE PEOPLE'S
COMMITTEE IN PRAGUE IN THE PAST FEW DAYS AND ABOUT FUTURE PLANS.
