

CS PARTY DID NOT TAKE MOSCOW'S VIEWS SUFFICIENTLY INTO ACCOUNT

MUNICH, SEPT 1 (CMD) - THE COMMUNIQUE ISSUED TONIGHT ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE PLENUM SAID THE PARTY HAD NOT TAKEN SUFFICIENT NOTE OF THE INTERESTS OF THE SOVIET UNION.

THE COMMUNIQUE WAS REFERRING TO A SPEECH MADE TO THE PLENUM BY PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK, BUT IT DID NOT MAKE IT CLEAR IF IT WAS ACTUALLY QUOTING FROM DUBCEK'S SPEECH.

IT SAID THAT IN EVALUATING THE POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BEFORE LAST JANUARY "OUR PARTY DID NOT SUFFICIENTLY TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE DARK AND REAL POWER OF INTERNATIONAL FACTORS, INCLUDING THE VIEWS HELD WITH REGARD TO OUR SITUATION BY THE STATES WITH WHOM WE ARE UNITED IN THE WARSAW PACT.

"WE DID NOT ALWAYS TAKE SUFFICIENT NOTE OF THE STRATEGIC AND GENERAL INTERESTS OF THE SOVIET UNION AND THE OTHER FOUR MEMBERS OF THE WARSAW PACT AS REAL, OBJECTIVELY EXISTING AND LIMITING FACTORS FOR THE POSSIBLE PACE AND FORM OF OUR OWN POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT."

IT SAID THAT AT THE MOSCOW TALKS, THE NEGOTIATORS HAD NOT PLACED THE MAIN EMPHASIS UPON PAST DEVELOPMENT. "THE CHANGED SITUATION WAS MARKED BY A NEW FACT, NAMELY THE ARRIVAL OF THE ARMIES OF THE FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES IN OUR COUNTRY."

THE COMMUNIQUE SAID "DUBCEK EMPHASIZED THAT THE LEADERSHIP OF THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY IS INTERESTED IN FINDING A SOLUTION FOR THE PRESENT SITUATION IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC AND IN OUR PARTY.

"WE MUST UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES AROUSE THE SUSPICION THAT WE MIGHT BE AVOIDING THE OBLIGATIONS WHICH WE HAVE ACCEPTED.
