DUBCEK WAS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT EVEN IN THESE "HARD TIMES THE PARTY REGARDED THE "CREATIVE APPROACH" WHICH SEEKS TO RESPECT FULLY "SPECIFIC" CZECHOSLOVAK CONDITION IN THE BUILDING OF SOCIALISM IN THE POST-JANUARY POLICY AS THE "MOST VALUABLE ASSET" OF THE PARTY AND THE BASIS OF THE CONFIDENCE OF THE WORKERS, PEASANTS INTELLIGENTSIA AND THE YOUNG GENERATION IN THE PARTY.
