TANJUG SAID THAT THE AUG 31 ISSUE OF THE BULGARIAN NEWSAGENCY ZEMEDEL'SKO ZNAME "WENT EVEN FURTHER IN THESE ATTACKS."

ZEMEDEL'SKO ZNAME HAD WARNED YUGOSLAVIA THAT THE TWO COUNTRIES WERE LIVING IN ONE PENINSULA ON ONE CONTINENT "AND ADDED, WITH A TONE OF WARNING, 'WE WILL SEE CALM' HERE," SAID TANJUG.

TANJUG SAID THAT THE AUG 31 ISSUE OF THE POLISH PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU NOT ONLY ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA'S STAND ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK ISSUE, BUT DEVELOPED A GENERAL ATTACK ON "THE BASIC LONG-TERM PRINCIPLES OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA, AND THEIR LEADERSHIP."

TRYBUNA LUDU HAD ALSO ATTACKED YUGOSLAVIA'S POLICY OF NON-ALIGNMENT, AND HAD "PROPAGATED THE THEORY OF SPHERES OF INFLUENCE WHICH IT SAID WAS AN INEVITABLE CONSEQUENCE OF THE DIVISION OF THE WORLD INTO TWO SYSTEMS."
