

X/9 P - POLISH TV ACCUSES ZIONISTS FOR CSSR CRISIS

WARSAW, SEPT. 1, REUTER--A POLISH TELEVISION REPORTER TONIGHT ACCUSED "ZIONISTS" OF PLAYING A BIG ROLE IN ANTI-COMMUNIST ACTIVITIES WHICH PROVOKED THE PRESENT CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS.

THE CHARGE, FOLLOWING SIMILAR ALLEGATIONS IN EARLIER ARTICLES AND SPEECHES, SEEMED PART OF AN OFFICIALLY-BACKED CAMPAIGN TO SHOW THAT UNPATRIOTIC JEWS WERE AMONG THE LEADING TROUBLEMAKERS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AS IN POLAND EARLIER THIS YEAR.

IN A TELEVISION BROADCAST FROM PRAGUE, MR. CZESLAW BERENDA SAID "ZIONIST FORCES" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF INTOLERANCE AND ANTI-COMMUNISM, HAD DESIGNATED FUTURE COMMUNIST LEADERS.

MR. BERENDA SAID THE SAME FORCES WERE THE MOST ACTIVE OF THOSE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WHO ATTACKED POLAND LAST MARCH -- WHEN NATIONWIDE STUDENT DEMONSTRATIONS FOR INTELLECTUAL AND DEMOCRATIC FREEDOMS ERUPTED INTO STREET CLASHES WITH MILITIA (POLICE).

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID MANY CZECHOSLOVAK ZIONISTS WERE WRITERS. HE NAMED:

MR. EDWARD GOLDSTUECKER, PRESIDENT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK WRITERS UNION;

MR. LADISLAV MNACKO, A NOVELIST WHO WENT TO ISRAEL LAST SUMMER "TO TRY TO FORCE THE PRAGUE GOVERNMENT TO REOPEN DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS," BROKEN OFF AFTER THE ARAB-ISRAELI WAR;

MR. ARNOST LUSTIG, A WRITER WHO "ATTACKED POLAND" AND

MR. JAN PROCHAZKA, OF THE PROGRESSIVE WRITERS NEWSPAPER, LITERARNY LISTY.

THE CORRESPONDENT ADDED THAT BY A STRANGE COINCIDENCE MANY OF THESE ZIONISTS WERE NO LONGER IN PRAGUE TO SHARE ITS "DIFFICULT DAYS." THEY HAD ESCAPED TO THE WEST WHERE THEY CONTINUED TO ATTACK THE WARSAW PACT ARMED INTERVENTION IN ARTICLES AND BROADCASTS.
