X/4 C/S - RADIO MOSCOW ATTACKS YUGOSLAV PARTY

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (CMD)-A RADIO MOSCOW COMMENTATOR YESTERDAY ACCUSED YUGOSLAVIA OF WANTING TO SPLIT CZECHOSLOVAKIA FROM THE WARSAW PACT.

THE COMMENT WAS MADE BY LEONID ZAVYALOV IN A RADIO MOSCOW ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSING THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND THE REACTIONS IT PROVOKED.

ZAVYALOV SAID THAT APART FROM WESTERN OPPOSITION, THE INVASION, HAD ALSO BEEN CRITICISED BY CHINA, RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA.

AFTER ATTACKING CHINA'S "SPLITTIST ATTITUDES," HE SAID:

"UNFORTUNATELY , THE YUGOSLAV LEADERSHIP HAS FOUND ITSELF IN THIS SAME COMPANY. THE TONE AND LINE OF ITS PROPAGANDA IS IN FACT DIRECTED AT THE SUPPORT OF THE COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY FORCES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"WHY IS THIS SO? ONE CAN ONLY ASSUME THAT BELGRADE HOPES THAT IT WILL SUCCEED IN SPLITTING CZECHOSLOVAKIA FROM THE COUNTRIES OF THE WARSAW PACT AND THEREBY JUSTIFYING TO ITS OWN COMMUNISTS THE PECULIAR COURSE WHICH YUGOSLAVIA HAS TAKEN."
