X/4 C/S -- BRATISLAVA CRITICIZES SOVIET CONTROLLED RADIO 'VLTAVA'

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (CMD)-- RADIO BRATISLAVA LAST NIGHT CRITICIZED THE SOVIET CONTROLLED RADIO STATION "VLTAVA" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

RADIO BRATISLAVA CARRIED WHAT IT CALLED "BRIEF CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PRESENT AIMS OF THE PROPAGANDA WHICH THE RADIO STATION VLTAVA CONTINUES TO BEAM AT CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID IN THE TRANSMISSIONS OF THE RUSSIAN SUPPORTED VLTAVA RADIO "THERE CAN BE FELT THE PIG-HEADED EFFORTS TO FIND EVIDENCE FOR COUNTERREVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND FOR THE AGREEMENT OF OUR PUBLIC WITH THE OCCUPATION OF OUR TERRITORY BY TROOPS OF THE WARSAW PACT."

RADIO BRATISLAVA WENT ON SAYING THAT "IF THERE IS NO RPT NO SUCH EVIDENCE, VLTAVA MUST INVENT THINGS, WHILE ITS EDITORS HAVE IMAGINATION."

RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID FURTHER THE RUSSIAN RADIO VLTAVA HAS "CHANGED ITS ATTITUDE TO THE NORMALIZATION OF THE LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

"WHILE IT SPOKE UNAMBIGUOUSLY, IN THE PREVIOUS DAYS, F A TEMPORARY STAY OF THE ALLIED ARMIES, THE RADIO STATION VLTAVA NOW SAYS THE COUNTERREVOLUTION HAS NOT RPT NOT BEEN ROUTED , BUT IT (THE COUNTERREVOLUTION) HAS CHANGED TACTICS, BY WHICH IT INDICATES THAT THE DEPARTURE OF THE FOREIGN TROOPS WILL BE A VERY COMPLEX MATTER."

RADIO BRATISLAVA WENT ON TO SAY THAT THE VLTAVA RADIO "RANKED ALSO PROFESSOR (EDUARD) GOLDSTUECKER WITH THE LEADERS OF COUNTERREVOLUTION."
