

X/9 CS - RELEAD TRYBUNA LUDU ON ZIONISTS

WARSAW, SEPT 2 (UPI)- THE POLISH COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU SAID TODAY THAT "ZIONIST" WRITERS AND THEIR "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY AND REVISIONIST THEORIES" STILL FOUND A RECEPTIVE EAR IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

A DESPATCH FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID ALTHOUGH TENSION WAS SLOWLY EASING AND SOME IMPORTANT DECISIONS HAVE BEEN TAKEN BY THE CZECH LEADERSHIP, THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES WERE NOT YET "FINISHED."

IT SAID NO ATTEMPTS HAVE YET BEEN MADE TO DRAW UP AN OBJECTIVE BALANCE SHEET OF THE MISTAKES WHICH HAD AN ADVERSE IMPACT ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEMOCRATIZATION PROCESS AND WHICH PROVIDED GROUND FOR "ANTI-SOCIALIST, REVISIONIST AND--TO BE QUITE FRANK-- ZIONIST FORCES."

TRYBUNA SAID THIS MATTER HAS BEEN RARELY RAISED IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA BECAUSE OF THE PAINFUL EXPERIENCES OF THE STALIN PERIOD, WHEN PEOPLE OF JEWISH ORIGIN SUFFERED INJUSTICE.

"THIS FACT, HOWEVER, CANNOT BY ANY MEANS ECLIPSE THE PRESENT REALITY, NAMELY, THAT IT WAS ZIONIST FORCES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WHICH LAUNCHED THE FIERCEST ATTACKS ON POLAND DURING THE MARCH EVENTS HERE," IT SAID.

A MANY JEWISH WRITERS, TRYBUNA SAID, ARE NO LONGER IN PRAGUE "SHARING WITH THE REST OF THE NATION THE DIFFICULT AND SOMETIMES PAINFUL EXPERIENCE. THEY ARE NOW IN THE WEST, IN THE CENTERS HOSTILE TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND POLAND."

SOME OF THE "ZIONIST" WRITERS, TRYBUNA CLAIMED, WANT TO TEAR CZECHOSLOVAKIA AWAY FROM THE SOCIALIST CAMP.

"IT WAS THEIR COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY AND REVISIONIST THEORIES THAT FOUND, AND STILL DO FIND, A RECEPTIVE EAR IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO AND AMONG SOME WRITERS WHO OPENLY CALL FOR THE ABOLITION OF THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT."
