

X/13/9 CS-- POLISH TV COMMENTATOR KAKOL DEFENDS CSSR INTERVENTION

BERLIN, SEP. 2 (RFE SPECIAL/WULFF)-- POLISH TELEVISION ON AUG. 31 CARRIED A PROGRAM ENTITLED "EVENING TALK" IN WHICH KAZIMIERZ KAKOL ATTACKED BONNS OSTPOLITIK.

IT WAS THE OBJECTIVE OF BONN'S OSTPOLITIK TO CHANGE THE ATTITUDE OF "EVERY" SOCIALIST STATE TOWARD WEST GERMANY FROM "HARD TO FLEXIBLE," KAKOL SAID.

TO A CERTAIN EXTENT WEST GERMANY HAD BEEN SUCCESSFUL IN THIS POLICY, CONSIDERING RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA, AND THE "POLICY OF SMILES TOWARD HUNGARY," WHICH WAS ALSO PART OF IT, KAKOL SAID.

HOWEVER, BONN'S FAILURES WERE FAR GREATER THAN ITS SUCCESSES. "BEFORE OUR EYES ONE OF THE MOST FAR-REACHING PLANS OF THE IMPERIALISTS BROKE DOWN," KAKOL SAID AND, REFERRING TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ADDED THAT IT WAS PLANNED TO "SWALLOW IT SILENTLY, WITHOUT MUCH FUSS, WITHOUT GIVING AWAY THE TRUE INTENTIONS."

KAKOL SAID THE "POLICY OF FLEXIBILITY" OF THE EAST EUROPEAN STATES TOWARD GERMANY HAD NOW ENDED. AFTER THE "EVENTS IN AUGUST" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA THE TIME HAD COME TO STRONGLY "CLOSE THE RANKS."

THE IMPERIALISTS HAD TO BURY THEIR HOPES, KAKOL SAID.

DEFENDING THE INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, KAKOL SAID WHEN A NEIGHBOR'S HOUSE IS ON FIRE "AND THREATENS TO SPREAD TO MY HOUSE, I AM JUSTIFIED IN TEARING DOWN THE BURNING ROOF, EVEN IF THE NEIGHBOR, STILL SLEEPY AND NOT ABLE TO REALIZE THE FULL DANGER, SHOULD PROTEST."

A NEW CONCEPT OF "SOVEREIGNTY OF A SOCIALIST STATE" HAD SHAPED UP AFTER AUGUST 1968, KAKOL SAID, ADDING THAT FROM NOW ON THE LIMITS OF FLEXIBILITY TOWARD WEST GERMANY HAD BEEN ESTABLISHED.
