X/4 C/S - CONSTITUENTS DEMAND KOLDER GIVE UP HIS ASSEMBLY SEAT

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (CMD)- THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY WILL DEBATE AT TODAY'S MEETING A DEMAND BY THE CITIZENS OF HAVIROV THAT DRAHOMIR KOLDER GIVE UP HIS SEAT IN THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, RADIO OSTRAVA SAID THIS MORNING.

THE FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF THIS NEWS ITEM:

"AT TODAY'S MEETING THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS TO DEBATE, AMONG OTHER THINGS, A DEMAND OF THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF HAVIROV THAT DRAHOMIR KOLDER BE RECALLED FROM HIS FUNCTION AS DEPUTY OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY.

"ELECTIONS WOULD BE HELD AT SHORT NOTICE SEPT 8. THE LOCAL NATIONAL COMMITTEE IN HAVIROV IS CAPABLE OF ORGANIZING THE ELECTION OF A NEW DEPUTY, BUT THE PRIOR CONSENT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS REQUIRED.

"THE CITIZENS OF HAVIROV PUBLICLY EXPRESSED THEIR DISAGREEMENT WITH THE INCUMBENT DEPUTY, DRAHOMIR KOLDER, IN LISTS OF SIGNATURES IN WHICH 34,302 CITIZENS DEMANDED THE RECALL OF DRAHOMIR KOLDER AS DEPUTY OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY," THE RADIO SAID.

(CMD)-- KOLDER WAS A MEMBER OF THE PRE-INVASION PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, BUT WAS NOT RPT NOT INCLUDED IN A NEW PRESIDUM ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY.
