

X/4 C/S - YUGOSLAV OFFICIAL CONDEMNS SOVIET INVASION

MUNICH, SEPT. 2 - (CMD)- TANJUG REPORTED TODAY THAT SERGEJ KRAJGER, PRESIDENT OF THE SLOVENIAN ASSEMBLY, HAD DECLARED THAT "NO RPT NO ACT OF THE SOVIET UNION HAS BEEN AS ISOLATED AND AS WIDELY CONDEMNED AS THE MILITARY INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

TANJUG SAID HE SPOKE IN THE SLOVENIAN TOWN OF METLIKA AT A PUBLIC RALLY MARKING THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FORMATION THERE OF A PARTISAN BRIGADE. THE DATE OF HIS SPEECH WAS NOT RPT NOT GIVEN.

TANJUG'S DISPATCH ON KRAJGER CONTINUED:

IN HIS SPEECH KRAJGER REFERRED ALSO TO THE CHAUVINIST HUE AND CRY OF BULGARIAN LEADERS AGAINST MACEDONIA, ONE OF THE SIX FEDERATED YUGOSLAV REPUBLICS, WHICH THEY CLAIM IS A PART OF BULGARIA.

WE ARE WITNESSING STRANGE CLAIMS, REFERENCES TO THE NEVER REALIZED TREATY OF SAN STEFANO CONCLUDED BETWEEN IMPERIALIST FORCES KRAJGER SAID. THIS WAS A HINT ON A TREATY SIGNED BY TSARIST RUSSIA AND TURKEY IN 1878 UNDER WHICH WHAT IS NOW THE REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA WAS TO HAVE COME UNDER BULGARIA.

ALSO, KRAJGER POINTED OUT THAT EVEN OPEN THREATS, HAD BEEN ADDRESSED FROM THE BULGARIAN SIDE SINCE THE ATTACK ON CZECHOSLOVAKIAS INDEPENDENCE.

HE SAID THAT THE VICTORY OF THE YUGOSLAV PEOPLES LIBERATION ARMY IN WORLD WAR TWO AND THE BROTHERHOOD AND UNITY OF THE PEOPLES AND NATIONALITIES OF YUGOSLAVIA WERE A SUFFICIENTLY CLEAR WARNING TO EVERYBODY NOT RPT NOT GO ENGAGE INTO ADVENTURES, BUT TO USE THE CONTINUOUS READINESS OF SOCIALIST YUGOSLAVIA FOR COOPERATION IN THE STRUGGLE FOR PEACE AND SOCIALISM, ON THE BASIS OF EQUALITY AND RESPECT OF SOVEREIGNTY OF THE PEOPLES AND COUNTRIES.
