

X/13 - WORLD - INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PHILOSOPHERS -
EAST EUROPEAN PARTICIPANTS (WITH CN 95)

VIENNA, SEPT 2 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA) -- ACCORDING TO AN OFFICIAL RELEASE, EAST EUROPE SHOULD BE REPRESENTED BY 446 PHILOSOPHERS AT THE CURRENT 14TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF PHILOSOPHY HELD IN VIENNA FROM 2ND TO 9 SEPTEMBER.

BUT THE FINAL LIST OF PARTICIPANTS WILL SHOW THAT NOT ALL THOSE WHO HAVE ACCEPTED INVITATIONS TURNED UP IN VIENNA, THE CONGRESS ORGANIZERS SAID THIS MORNING. THEY POINTED OUT THAT FOR INSTANCE 54 POLISH SCIENTISTS WERE EXPECTED TO COME BUT ONLY 14 REGISTERED TO NOW WITH THE CONGRESS SECRETARIATE.

THE OVERALL NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS WAS EXPECTED TO REACH 3,000 SCIENTISTS FROM 65 COUNTRIES.

THE FOLLOWING LIST CONTAINS ALL WHO HAVE ACCEPTED INVITATIONS EXCEPT POLAND WHERE ONLY THOSE PRESENT IN VIENNA ARE LISTED. THE FINAL LIST OF PARTICIPANTS WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLY WITHIN FEW DAYS, THE ORGANIZERS SAID.
