INSTANCES OF HUNGARIAN SUPPORT FOR DUBCEK
MUNICH, SEPT 2 (CMD)- RADIO BRATISLAVA BROADCASTING IN HUNGARIAN TODAY REPORTED SOME INSTANCES OF SUPPORT FOR CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK AND PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA FROM THE HUNGARIAN MINORITY IN SLOVAKIA.

IN THE NYITRA UNIVERSITY DISTRICT A "GO HOME" SLOGAN PAINTED ON A BUILDING HAS BEEN PUT THERE "BY HUNGARIANS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA LOYAL TO SOCIALIST DEMOCRACY, NOT RPT NOT COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES," RADIO BRATISLAVA SAID.

THE COMMUNIST PARTY COMMITTEE OF LOSONC, PEOPLE OF THE VILLAGE OF NYELSOC AND STUDENTS OF THE FULEK ARCHITECTURAL INSTITUTE HAVE PLEDGED THEIR SUPPORT TOSVOBODA, DUBCEK AND THE LEADERSHIP OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, "TO CREATE THE CONDITIONS FOR THE SPEEDY WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN MILITARY UNITS," THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO ADDED THAT IT WAS EXPECTED THAT THESE BATTERIES WOULD BE AVAILABLE WITHIN THE NEXT FEW DAYS, SINCE THE FACTORY HAD BEEN WORKING WITHOUT ANY INTERRUPTION.
