MUST PEOPLE THEREFORE GIVE UP HOPES OF A DETENTE AND OF PEACE? THE PONTIFF ASKED.

INSTEAD, MUST NOT RPT NOT PEOPLE TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION, WITH COURAGE AND REALISM, THE MEANS SUITABLE TO CONSOLIDATE THESE HOPES? POPE PAUL SAID.

HE SAID THAT THE UNIFICATION OF EUROPE, A LONG-RANGE GOAL OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE, WAS ONE OF THE SUREST PATHS TO THESE HOPES.

POPE PAUL SAID THAT THE MEMBER-NATIONS OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE MUST REINFORCE THEIR SOLIDARITY SO AS TO MAKE HEARD, IN A FIRM AND PEACEFUL MANNER, THE VOICE OF REASON AND JUSTICE.

HE SAID THE 18 COUNTRIES REPRESENTED IN THE COUNCIL MUST TAKE TO HEART THE LARGE-SCALE INTERNATIONAL CAUSES OF THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DEMANDS OF JUSTICE .

SUCH A GENEROUS AND DISINTERESTED ATTITUDE, THE PONTIFF SAID, COULD NOT RPT NOT REMAIN WITHOUT RESULTS AND IS A WORTHY MEANS OF PROMOTING COOPERATION AMONG THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.

(REUTER) YESTERDAY THE POPE DENOUNCED THE "POLICE NIGHTMARE" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IN HIS USUAL SUNDAY MIDDAY BLESSING OF PILGRIMS.

"THE FOUNDATIONS OF INTERNATIONAL ORDER HAVE BEEN SHAKEN," HE SAID.

"ONE AGAIN THE ABUSE OF ARMS AND INTIMIDATION HAVE BEEN USED TO DETERMINE RELATIONS BETWEEN NATIONS."

BUT HE EXPRESSED A FEELING OF HELPLESSNESS AT IT ALL, SAYING: "A FEELING OF IMPOTENCE AND FATALISM OFTEN FILLS THE MINDS OF THOSE WHO SUFFER VIOLENCE AND THOSE WHO OBSERVE WITHOUT BEING ABLE TO HELP."
