(UPI) KADLEC THANKED STUDENTS FOR THEIR "PROUD PATRIOTISM."

HE SAID STUDENTS AND YOUTH HAD MANAGED, WITHOUT WAVERING, TO FIND THEIR CORRECT PLACE IN SOCIETY.

"THEIR ATTITUDE HAS BEEN PROOF OF THE PRICELESS MORAL CHARACTER, EPIC MATURITY, AND NOBILITY OF YOUR YOUTH," HE SAID.

KADLEC SAID FOR THE FIRST TIME, STUDENTS DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR WILL BE HELPING IN THE ECONOMY, PARTICULARLY AGRICULTURE, OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. CHILDREN'S AND YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS HAVE COME FORWARD WITH A PROJECT CALLED "SERVICE TO THE FATHERLAND" WHICH WILL APPEAL TO ALL YOUNG PEOPLE TO GIVE THEIR ASSISTANCE TO THE REPUBLIC IN THE DIFFICULT DAYS AHEAD, HE SAID.

KADLEC SAID AID TO SCHOOLS WOULD BE INTENSIFIED, IN SPITE OF THE RECENT DAMAGE TO THE COUNTRY'S ECONOMY.

"WE DO NOT INTEND TO RETREAT FROM A COURSE OF FURTHERING THE DEMOCRATIC AND HUMANISTIC PRINCIPLES ESSENTIAL TO SOCIALISM. IN THAT SENSE, OUR SCHOOLS ARE BECOMING ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT IDEOLOGICAL PILLARS OF OUR SOCIETY," KADLEC SAID.
