

X/4/9 C/S - ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES WANT TO MISLEAD C/S SOCIETY, SAYS  
WARSAW

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (RADIO WARSAW SAID TODAY THAT  
"ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA RESORTED TO ALL  
MEANS TO MISLEAD THE PEOPLE AND HINDER THE PROCESS OF  
NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN THE COUNTRY.

HOWEVER, THE RADIO ALSO SPOKE OF "VISIBLE PASSING OF  
CURRENT TENSION."

"ONE CAN NOTICE CHANGES IN MANY FIELDS. NERVOUS CRIES ABOUT  
THE CZECH PARTY, AND OPENLY HOSTILE BEHAVIOUR AGAINST THE  
SOVIET UNION AND OTHER SOCIALIST COUNTRIES WHICH IN DIFFICULT  
MOMENTS HAVE RENDERED HELP TO THE NATIONS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA  
ARE DISAPPEARING FROM RADIO BROADCASTS AND FROM THE PAGES  
OF PRAGUE'S PRESS," THE RADIO SAID.

IT SAID THAT CORRESPONDENTS STRESSED AT THE SAME TIME  
THAT "INSTIGATING AND INSULTING" INSCRIPTIONS HAVE NOT AS YET  
BEEN ERASED FROM MANY BUILDINGS AT WENCESLAS SQUARE AND IN THE STREETS  
AROUND I.

"ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES ARE RESORTING TO ALL MEANS  
IN ORDER TO MISLEAD SOCIETY AND HINDER THE PROCESS OF THE  
NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

"THE CORRESPONDENTS REPORT THAT GROUPS OF WORKERS AND  
STUDENT YOUTH ARE LEAVING TOWNS TO HELP HARVESTING. THE SOVIET  
SOLDIERS ARE ALSO HELPING THE CZECH AND SLOVAKS BOYS," SAID THE RADIO.

IT ADDED THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE,  
THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC, THE GOVERNMENT AND THE  
CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ARE TAKING EXTRAORDINARY  
MEASURES TO NORMALIZE LIFE AND STRENGTHEN THE LEADING ROLE OF
