X/13 W/GER - YUGOSLAV AND RUMANIAN UNION LEADERS CONDEMN CS

OCCUPATION

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (DPA/GND) - YUGOSLAV AND RUMANIAN TRADE UNION LEADERS IN MUNICH CONDEMNED TODAY THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY WARSAW PACT TROOPS.

BOTH WERE ADDRESSING THE ANNUAL CONGRESS OF THE WEST GERMAN METAL WORKERS UNION (IG METALL) WHICH OPENED HERE TODAY.

THE SECRETARY OF THE YUGOSLAV METAL WORKERS UNION, BORIVOJE NAJDANOVIC, SAID THAT THE YUGOSLAV WORKERS ^RWEE_A CONDEMNING THE OCCUPATION OF THE CSSR AS "A FLAGRANT VIOLATION OF THE RIGHT OF EVERY COUNTRY TO PURSUE THE PATH OF ITS OWN DEVELOPMENT."

HE ADDED THAT THERE WAS NOT RPT NOT A SINGLE REASON TO JUSTIFY THE ACTION AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA. IN ADDITION THERE HAS BEEN NO DANGER OF MILITARY INTERVENTION BY THE WEST IN THE CSSR, HE SAID.

THE SECRETARY OF THE RUMANIAN METAL WORKERS, DRAGOMIR MOISIN, SAID THAT THE TRADE UNIONS OF HIS COUNTRY WERE AGAINST THE METHODS USED BY THE FIVE COUNTRIES AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA. THE RUMANIAN TRADE UNIONS WERE ALSO FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE WARSAW PACT TROOPS FROM THE CSSR.

THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE SHOULD AGAIN BE PUT IN THE POSITION TO FREELY PERFECT SOCIALISM, MOISIN ADDED.
