X/4 C/S -- COMMUNISTS IN CENTRAL BOHEMIA REVIEW STAND

MUNICH, SEPT 2 -- (CMD) -- COMMUNISTS IN CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID TODAY THEY WOULD LIKE TO BELIEVE THAT THE PRESENT MILITARY INTERVENTION IN THE CSSR IS NOT DIRECTED AGAINST POST-JANUARY DEVELOPMENTS THERE.

THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN COMMUNIST PARTY WHICH MET TODAY IN PRAGUE MADE THE STATEMENT IN A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZED BY RADIO PRAGUE TONIGHT.

THE RADIO DID NOT RPT NOT SAY WHERE THE MEETING TOOK PLACE.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, THE RESOLUTION ISSUED BY THE MEETING SAID:

"WE WOULD LIKE TO BELIEVE THAT THE MILITARY INTERVENTION IS NOT DIRECTED AGAINST OUR POST-JANUARY DEVELOPMENT, AND WE WILL STRIVE TO CONTINUE IT FURTHER.

"THE PEOPLE IN OUR COUNTRY ARE CONSCIOUS THAT IF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY FAILS TO DEFEND ITS POLICY NOBODY WILL DEFEND IT. FOR THIS REASON WE SO SPONTANEOUSLY SUPPORT OUR PARTY IN THESE DIFFICULT MOMENTS.

"WE WILL DO OUR UTMOST THAT THE POSITIVE VALUES OF THE POST-JANUARY DEVELOPMENT ARE PRESERVED, AND THAT DEMOCRATIC AND HUMANIST FEATURES OF SOCIALISM CONTINUE TO BE DEVELOPED FURTHER IN OUR COUNTRY," SAID THE RESOLUTION.

THE RADIO ADDED THAT THE PLENUM OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE WAS ALSO ATTENDED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE REGIONAL CONTROL AND AUDITING COMMISSION, AND THE LEADING SECRETARIES OF THE PARTY DISTRICT COMMITTEES.

IT SAID THAT THE LEADING SECRETARY OF THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE JAN PILLER ACQUAINTED THE PLENUM WITH THE TALKS AND THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE PLENUM OF AUG 31.

THE RADIO SAID THAT AT THE

DISCUSSION WHICH DEVELOPED AT THE REGIONAL PLENUM MUCH ATTENTION WAS DEDICATED TO THE QUESTIONS HOW TO PROCEED IN THE NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONS IN THE WORK OF PARTY ORGANS, AND THAT OF MUNICIPAL COMMITTEES, WHERE SOME PROBLEMS WERE APPEARING IN CONTACTS WITH THE UNITS OF FOREIGN ARMIES FOR WHICH THE GOVERNMENT HAS NOT ISSUED UP TO NOW ANY DIRECTIVES.

THE RADIO SAID THAT FOR EXAMPLE, IT WAS THE QUESTION OF SUPPLYING FOREIGN MILITARY UNITS WITH FUEL, CASES WERE INCREASING, SAID THE RADIO, IN WHICH THE MEMBERS OF FOREIGN ARMIES POSSESSED CZECHOSLOVAK CURRENCY, AND WERE BUYING SMALL INDUSTRIAL ARTICLE. (RADIO PRAGUE DOMESTIC/M SEPT 2, 1968, 1910)
