#### CS ACADEMY OF SCIENCES EVACUATED BY TROOPS

MUNICH, SEPT 2 (CMD) - CZECHOSLOVAK ACADEMY OF SCIENCES HAS BEEN EVACUATED BY FOREIGN TROOPS AND SCIENTISTS ENTERED THE BUILDING FOR THE FIRST TIME TODAY, RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA REPORTED TONIGHT.

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT "THE CZECHOSLOVAK ACADEMY OF SCIENCES HAS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF PREPARED SCIENTIFIC MEETINGS IN OUR COUNTRY. AMONG THOSE CANCELLED," THE RADIO SAID, "IS THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE MARKING THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WHICH HAD BEEN SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER OF THIS YEAR." #### SWISS OPEN FIRST "WELCOME CAMP" FOR CS CITIZENS

GENEVA, SEPT. 2 (RFE SPECIAL/MAHONEY)-- SWITZERLAND TODAY OPENED AT BUCHS THE FIRST OF ITS TWO "WELCOME CAMPS" FOR CZECHOSLOVAKS STRANDED IN THIS COUNTRY.

THE FIRST FIVE CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS WERE ACCEPTED FOR PROCESSING TODAY, ACCORDING TO A SPOKESMAN FOR THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT.

A GREAT MANY MORE ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW. THEIR PROCESSING WILL TAKE FROM TWO TO THREE DAYS. THEN THEY WILL BE PASSED ON TO STAY WITH SWISS FAMILIES.

MORE THAN 700 FAMILIES HAVE ALREADY ASKED AUTHORITIES TO SEND THEM CZECHOSLOVAKS. THERE WERE ABOUT 600 CZECHOSLOVAKS STRANDED IN THIS COUNTRY AT THE TIME OF THE OCCUPATION.

ALL CZECHOSLOVAKS ARE GIVEN FREE VISAS, GOOD FOR THREE MONTHS, AND EXTENDABLE.

#### TITO DISCUSSES SITUATION

BELGRADE, SEP 2, REUTER - PRESIDENT TITO DISCUSSED THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION WITH YUGOSLAVIA'S COMMUNIST LEADERSHIP ON BRIONI ISLAND TODAY, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TONIGHT.

THE WARSAW PACT OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS ASSUMED TO HAVE BEEN THE MAIN SUBJECT.

THE NEWS AGENCY TANJUG SAID THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE PRESIDUM AND EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ATTENDED THE SESSION, ANALYSED THE LATEST INTERNATIONAL SITUATION, AND DISCUSSED TASKS ARISING FROM IT.

NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN.
