X/4 C/S - LOCAL AUTHORITY SAYS CONSIDERABLE DAMAGE CAUSED

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) - THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF CENTRAL SLOVAKIA SAID YESTERDAY THAT THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAS CAUSED "CONSIDERABLE ECONOMIC DAMAGE, AND DISTURBED THE NORMAL COURSE OF OUR POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC LIFE," RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED TONIGHT.

THE RADIO REPORTED ON A PLENARY SESSION OF THE CENTRAL SLOVAK REGIONAL NATIONAL COMMITTEE WHICH WAS HELD IN BASNKA BYSTRICA MONDAY.

THE RADIO SAID THE PLENUM "DISCUSSED THE CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION AND MEASURES FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC LIFE IN CENTRAL SLOVAKIA."

ACCORDING TO RADIO BRATISLAVA, "IN ITS STANDPOINT, THE PLENUM OF THE CENTRAL SLOVAK REGIONAL NATIONAL COMMITTEE EXPRESSES ITS FULL DEVOTION AND SUPPORT TO THE NEWLY ELECTED CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, HEADED BY COMRADE DR. GUSTAV HUSAK, (DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER.)"

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT THE PLENUM "HAD TAKEN MEASURES FOR THE ASSURANCE OF A SPEEDY CONSOLIDATION OF THE POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC LIFE IN THE CENTRAL SLOVAK REGION."
