

X/4 C/S -- SOVIET-SUPPORTED RADIO STOPS BROADCASTING

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) -- A SOVIET-SUPPORTED RADIO STATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA -- "VOICE OF THE WORKERS OF THE REPUBLIC" -- ANNOUNCED THIS MORNING IT WOULD STOP BROADCASTING. IT THEN WENT OFF THE AIR AND HAS NOT RPT NOT BEEN HEARD SINCE.

HOWEVER, ANOTHER SOVIET-SPONSORED RADIO STATION, VLTAVA, REMAINED ON THE AIR IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE LAST WORDS OF THE "VOICE OF THE WORKERS OF THE REPUBLIC" WERE:

"TODAY WE WILL SWITCH OFF THE MICROPHONE OF THE WORKERS VOICE OF THE REPUBLIC. WE HAVE FULFILLED OUR PATRIOTIC AND PARTY TASK. THE HISTORY OF THE RECENT DAYS HAS CONFIRMED THAT WE WERE RIGHT...

"WE ARE CEASING OUR ACTIVITY. GUIDED BY PARTY DISCIPLINE AND BY THE PRINCIPLES OF DEMOCRATIC CENTRALISM WE OBEY THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE LATEST PLENUM OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE NEWLY ELECTED PRESIDUM," THE BROADCAST SAID.

"WE MUST NOT RPT NOT AND WE DO NOT RPT NOT WANT THAT OUR ACTIVITY BE CONSIDERED FACTIONAL. WE SUPPORT THE LEADERSHIP OF THE PARTY AND OF THE GOVERNMENT HEADED BY COMRADES (LUDVIK) SVOBODA, (ALEXANDER) DUBCEK, AND (OLDRICH) CERNIK. WE SUPPORT THEM IN THE EFFORT AIMED AT THE REALIZATION OF THE MAY CONCLUSIONS, THE CONCLUSIONS OF CIERNA-NAD-TISOU AND OF BRATISLAVA, AS WELL AS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS", THE RADIO DECLARED. (MORE)
