

C/S -- NEPSZAVA REGRETS LACK OF UNDERSTANDING

BUDAPEST, SEP 3 (UPI)-- A BUDAPEST COMMUNIST NEWSPAPER REGRETTED TODAY THAT "THE LEADERS OF SOME COMMUNIST WORKERS PARTIES DID NOT UNDERSTAND THE ESSENTIALS OF THE ASSISTANCE GRANTED BY THE FIVE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE HUNGARIAN TRADE UNION NEWSPAPER NEPSZAVA, COMMENTING ON THE NEGATIVE ATTITUDE OF SOME COMMUNIST PARTIES ON THE ARMED INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WROTE THAT "WE DO NOT DENY THAT THERE DO EXIST DIFFERENT OPINIONS ON THE COMMUNIST WORLD MOVEMENT.
