X/4¹/₉C/S -- COMMUNIST COMMENT ON C/S PARTY PLENUM

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) -- THE POLISH PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU TODAY REPORTED ON THE PLENARY SESSION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY UNDER THE HEADLINE: "A CERTAIN PROGRESS."

THIS WAS REPORTED BY PAP, WHICH SAID THE REPORT WAS FROM THE NEWSPAPER'S PRAGUE CORRESPONDENT Z. BRONIAREK, WHO WROTE:

"TO MAKE AN ASSESSMENT OF THE PLENARY MEETING OF THE C.P.C. CENTRAL COMMITTEE ONE SHOULD REFER TO A STATEMENT MADE BY THE FIRST SECRETARY A. DUBCEK. FOR THE FIRST TIME DUBCEK TACKLED THE HEART OF THE MATTER WHICH CONCERNS NOT ONLY THE RECENT SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA BUT ALSO THE NECESSITY TO DEFEND THE WHOLE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY.

"A. DUBCEK SAID THAT THE PARTY HAD MADE SERIOUS MISTAKE IN ITS EVALUATION OF THIS NECESSITY AND OF THE ATTITUDE OF FRATERNAL PARTIES TOWARDS THE DEVELOPMENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO KEEP ITS LEADING ROLE. IN OTHER WORDS, THE STATEMENT AMOUNTED TO A CONFESSION THAT FRATERNAL PARTIES HAD A GOOD REASON TO BE ANXIUS."
