"TO NEGATE THIS , ADVANCING THE THEORY OF A DUTY TO INTERVENE, UNREQUESTED BY THE INTERESTED LEADERSHIP ORGANISMS OF THE PARTY AND OF THE GOVERNMENT, MEANS TO NEGATE THE PRINCIPLES OF AUTONOMY EQUALITY, SOVEREIGNTY AND NON-INTERFERENCE TO WHICH, (PRAVDA) AFFIRMS, IT WANTS TO BE FAITHFUL."

UNITA ALSO ACCUSED THE PRAVDA ARTICLE OF EXPRESSING THE DECISIVE ROLE OF THE SOVIET UNION IN "TERMS THAT SEEM TO BE NOW SURPASSED IN RESPECT TO THE NEW ACQUISITIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL WORKERS MOVEMENTS THAT HAD BROUGHT -- FIRST OF ALL THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY -- TO REFUSING THE CONCEPT OF THE GUIDE STATE."

UNITA ADDED THAT ITS CRITICISM WAS INTENDED TO BE FRATERNAL AND NOT POLEMICAL.

"WE SAY THESE THINGS FRANKLY, WITHOUT POLEMICAL SPIRIT AND WITHOUT PRESUMPTIONS, CONVINCED OF BEING IN THE RIGHT AND IN ANY CASE NOT CERTAIN OF BEING IN THE LIST OF THOSE PERSONS DECEIVED BY IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA." IT SAID.
