

X/4 C/S -- SITUATION IN SLOVAKIA

MUNICH, SEPT 3 (CMD) -- VARIOUS PARTY BODIES IN SLOVAKIA HELD MEETINGS YESTERDAY AT WHICH PARTY MEMBERS WERE INFORMED ABOUT THE CURRENT SITUATION, RADIO BRATISLAVA REPORTED THIS MORNING.

THE MEMBERS OF THE PLENUM OF THE WEST SLOVAK REGIONAL COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY WERE APPRAISED OF THE COURSE AND RESULTS OF THE LAST MEETING OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND ABOUT THE CONDITIONS FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA CONTAINED IN THE MOSCOW ACCORD. THE RADIO SAID TWO MAIN QUESTIONS WERE ASKED IN THE DEBATE:

"WHAT GUARANTEES ARISE FOR US FROM THE FULFILLMENT OF THE ACCORD AND WHAT IS THE CONTENT OF ADDITIONAL POINTS IN THIS ACCORD?"

TWO MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDUM OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, JOSEF ZRAK AND ANTON TAZKY, INFORMED AN AKTIF OF PARTY MEMBERS IN BANSKA BYSTRICA ABOUT THE SITUATION AND THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, AS WELL AS ABOUT THE LAST MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY.

JOSEF ZRAK EMPHASIZED THAT ANTI-SOVIET PROPAGANDA MUST BE STOPPED, ACCORDING TO THE RADIO.

A DISTRICT AKTIF OF BASIC PARTY ORGANIZATION OFFICIALS WAS ALSO HELD IN TRNAVA, WHERE PROFESSOR VICTOR PAVLEND, SECRETARY OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE INFORMED THE MEMBERS ABOUT THE SITUATION.

THREE "CONSULTATION CENTERS" HAVE BEEN OPENED IN THIS DISTRICT TO MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO PARTY MEMBERS AND THOSE WITHOUT PARTY AFFILIATION, THE RADIO SAID.
