GENEVA -- 1ST ADD BRANDT CALLS FOR (CN 64) XXX CONFERENCE

"WE WILL TRY TO ACHIEVE A PROHIBITION OF ANY AGGRESSION WITH NUCLEAR, BIOLOGICAL, CHEMICAL AND CONVENTIONAL WEAPONS, AS WELL AS OF THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT THREAT OF SUCH AN AGGRESSION, AS A BREACH OF THE GENERALLY VALID PRINCIPLE OF NON-VIOLENCE THAT IS ALSO LAID DOWN IN THE PRINCIPLES OF ARTICLE TWO OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER," BRANDT SAID.

HE SAID WEST GERMANY HAS PROPOSED THE "ELIMINATION OF CONFRONTATION" IN EUROPE, RECIPROCAL RENUNCIATIONS OF THE USE OF FORCE, NORMALIZATION OF RELATIONS WITH THE COUNTRIES OF EASTERN AND SOUTH-EASTERN EUROPE, A MODUS VIVENDI IN GERMANY, AND FACILITATED EXCHANGES IN THE CULTURAL, ECONOMIC AND SCIENTIFIC FIELDS.
