X/13 C/S -- EAST GERMAN PRESS: COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES CONTINUE

BERLIN, SEP 3 (RFE SPECIAL/WULFF) -- EAST GERMANY'S MAJOR NEWSPAPERS TODAY MOVED LENGTHY REPORTS ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA TO THEIR INSIDE PAGES AND CARRIED ONLY ONE ITEM EACH DEALING WITH THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS THERE ON THEIR FRONT PAGE.

THE OFFICIAL EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER NEUES DEUTSCHLAND IN A SHORT FRONT-PAGE ITEM SAID THAT WHILE THE CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS WERE TRYING TO "NORMALIZE" THEIR LIFE, THE "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES ARE CONTINUING WITH THEIR SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES." THE PAPER SAID THE "STRONGHOLDS OF THESE ACTIVITIES" WERE THE "CENTERS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE: THE JALTA, ESPLANADE AND ALCRON HOTELS."

SIMILAR REPORTS APPEARED ON THE FRONT PAGES OF JUNGE WELT, THE ORGAN OF EAST GERMANY'S OFFICIAL YOUTH ORGANIZATION, FDJ, AND "WAHRHEIT," THE NEWSPAPER OF THE WEST BERLIN COMMUNIST SED (COMMUNIST PARTY).
