X/13 - E/W -- VIENNA COMMUNIST YOUTH ORGANIZATION'S PROTEST

VIENNA, SEPT 3 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA) -- THE VIENNA COMMUNIST YOUTH ORGANIZATION SAID LAST NIGHT THAT THE MILITARY INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA REPRESENTS A VIOLATION OF THE BRATISLAVA AGREEMENT.

ACCORDING TO PROTESTS RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE VIENNA COORGANIZATION OF THE COMMUNIST "FREE AUSTRIAN YOUTH," THE RESULTS OF THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW ARE "NO GUARANTEE FOR A CONTINUATION OF THE DEMOCRATIZATION PROCESS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE PRESENCE OF FOREIGN TROOPS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA REPRESENTS AN INTERFERENCE IN INTERNAL CZECHOSLOVAK AFFAIRS, RESTRICTIONS AND CONTROL OF THE PARTY AND STATE LEADERSHIP, THE RESOLUTION SAID.

RECALLING THE BRATISLAVA MEETING, THE RESOLUTION SAID THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA REPRESENTS "A ONE -SIDED VIOLATION OF THE BRATISLAVA AGREEMENT BY THE FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES".

"WE DEMAND THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF CONDITIONS AS DEFINED BY THE BRATISLAVA AGREEMENT AND WE SUPPORT THE AUSTRIAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND ITS INITIATIVE AIMED AT A CONFERENCE OF ALL WEST EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTIES", THE RESOLUTION CONCLUDED.
