BREZHNEV RECEIVES TSEDENBAL

MOSCOW, SEPT. 3 (CMD) -- SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY CHIEF LEONID BREZHNEV TODAY RECEIVED MONGOLIAN PARTY CHIEF YUMZHAGIN TSEDENBAL, TASS REPORTS.

THE DISPATCH SAID THEY DISCUSSED "QUESTIONS OF FURTHER STRENGTHENING OF FRIENDSHIP AND COOPERATION" AND THAT "THEY ALSO DISCUSSED SOME PROBLEMS OF INTERNATIONAL POLICY AND THE WORLD COMMUNIST MOVEMENT."

"A COMPLETE IDENTITY OF VIEWS WAS CONFIRMED ON ALL QUESTIONS," TASS ADDED.

MUNICH, SEPT. 3 (CMD) -- THE EGYPTIAN NEWS AGENCY MENA TODAY QUOTED THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN CAIRO AS SAYING THERE IS NO RPT NO TRUTH IN REPORTS THAT CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN MINISTER JIRI HAJEK INTENDS TO FORM A GOVERNMENT-IN-EXILE.

(CMD) HAJEK WAS IN YUGOSLAVIA WHEN HIS COUNTRY WAS INVADED. HE SUBSEQUENTLY FLEW TO NEW YORK, THEN BACK TO BELGRADE AND IS NOW IN SWITZERLAND.

THE TEXT OF THE MEAN REPORT:

THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN CAIRO TODAY CATEGORICALLY DENIED NEWS AGENCY REPORTS THAT CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN MINISTER JIRI HAJEK INTENDS TO FORM A CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT IN EXILE. THE EMBASSY SAID THESE RUMORS ARE GROUNDLESS AND ONLY AIM AT HARMING HAJEK, WHO OCCUPIES THE POST OF FOREIGN MINISTER IN THE LEGITIMATE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT."
