X/13 W GER -- FDP DEMANDS BRIEFING ON KIESINGER-TSARAPKIN MEETING
(W/CN 69)

BONN, SEPT 3 (RFE SPECIAL/MARSH) -- THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE FREE DEMOCRATIC PARTY, HANS-DIETRICH GENSCHER, TODAY DEMANDED THAT CHANCELLOR KIESINGER INFORM ALL PARTIES REPRESENTED IN THE BUNDESTAG ON THE TOPICS DISCUSSED YESTERDAY BETWEEN THE CHANCELLOR AND THE SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO BONN, SEMYON TSARAPKIN.

GENSCHER SAID THE PARLIAMENT MUST NOT BE LEFT UNINFORMED ON ESSENTIAL FOREIGN POLICY MATTERS, "AS WAS THE CASE IN THE SOVIET UNIONS CLAIMED RIGHT TO INTERVENE (IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA)."

THE DEPUTY FDP LEADER ALSO CALLED ON THE GOVERNMENT TO KEEP ALL PARTIES IN THE BUNDESTAG INFORMED ON DEVELOPMENTS REGARDING TALKS WITH EAST GERMAN LEADERS.

SUCH INFORMATION WAS NOT MERELY TO OBLIGE THE OPPOSITION, GENSCHER SAID, "BUT SHOULD BE REGARDED AS A MATTER OF COURSE IN DIVIDED GERMANY.
