

VISITS - DUTCH MP'S TO BUCHAREST

AMSTERDAM, SEPT 3 (CNR/AFP)- A NETHERLANDS PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION OF THIRTEEN PEOPLE LEFT AMSTERDAM THIS MORNING FOR AN EIGHT-DAY OFFICIAL VISIT TO BUCHAREST.

THE DELEGATION WILL BE THE GUEST OF THE RUMANIAN GOVERNMENT.

IT IS COMPOSED OF DEPUTIES AND SENATORS OF ALL THE PRINCIPAL PARTIES IN THE NETHERLANDS AND IS LED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SOCIALIST FFACTION IN THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES, M.H. NEDERHORST.

THE DATE OF THE TRIP WAS FIXED LAST YEAR AFTER THE OFFICIAL VISIT TO RUMANIAN BY THE DUTCH FOREIGN MINISTER, MR. JOSEPH LUNS.

THE DUTCH DELEGATION WILL BE RECEIVED IN RUMANIA BY THE PRESIDENT AND PARTY LEADER, MR. NICOLAE CEAUSESCU, AS WELL AS BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUMANIAN NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, MR. STEFAN VOITEC.

THEY WILL ALSO DISCUSS WITH THEIR OPPOSITE NUMBERS IN THE RUMANIAN NATIONAL ASSEMBLY QUESTIONS OF MUTUAL INTEREST, INCLUDING THE SITUATION IN EUROPE.

A SIMILAR DELEGATION WAS TO HAVE GONE TO POLAND LAST WEEK, BUT THE TRIP WAS CANELLED BECAUSE OF THE PARTICIPATION OF POLISH TROOPS IN THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
