X/4 C/S -- PARLIAMENT TO MEET PROBABLY NEXT WEEK

MUNICH, SEPT 3 -- (CMD) -- RADIO PRAGUE SAID TONIGHT THAT A PLENARY SESSION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY (PARLIAMENT) WILL TAKE PLACE "PROBABLY" NEXT WEEK.

THE RADIO SAID THE PARLIAMENT PRESIDUM WILL MEET ON THURSDAY AND WILL LAY DOWN THE PROGRAM OF THE NEXT PLENARY SESSION.

RADIO PRGUE SAID THAT "UNDOUBTEDLY" THE PLENUM WILL DISCUSS THE MOST URGENT LAWS ABOUT THE NATIONAL FRONT, SOME MEASURES IN THE FIELD OF THE PRESS AND OTHER MASS COMMUNICATION MEDIA AND SOME OTHER LAWS.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECH NATIONAL COUNCIL WILL MEET TOMORROW MORNING TO DISCUSS TASKS CONNECTED WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE FEDERATIVE ARRANGEMENT OF THE COUNTRY.

DURING THIS WEEK, COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES HEADED BY CESTMIR CISAR WILL TRAVEL TO SLOVAKIA WHERE THEY WILL NEGOTIATE WITH THE LEADING REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL.

IN ANOTHER REPORT TONIGHT, PRAGUE RADIO SAID THAT THE MAIN BUILDING OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN PRAGUE HAS BEEN "RELEASED" TUESDAY AFTERNOON.

THE RADIO ADDED THAT WARSAW TREATY TROOPS THIS AFTERNOON RELEASED THE BUILDING OF THE CETEKA NEWS AGENCY IN PRAGUE. (RADIO PRAGUE DOMESTIC/M 1900, RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN GERMAN/F 1800)
