X/4 C/S --1ST ADD PARLIAMENT TO MEET (CN 173) XXX PRAGUE

RADIO PRAGUE SAID TONIGHT (1900) PREPARATORY WORK IS BEING CARRIED OUT FOR THE RESUMPTION OF BROADCASTING IN THE MAIN RADIO BUILDING.

THE STAFF OF CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN PRAGUE WILL BE ADVISED IN TIME AS TO WHEN NORMAL WORK COMMENCES IN THE BUILDING, AND WHEN THEY ARE TO REPORT FOR WORK, RADIOPRAGUE SAID.

CETKA EMPLOYEES, TOO, ARE PREPARING THEIR BUILDING FOR FURTHER WORK.

IN ANOTHER REPORT TONIGHT (1900), RADIOPRAGUE REPORTED ABOUT AN INTERIOR MINISTRY ANNOUNCEMENT SAYING THAT AUTHORITIES HAD TAKEN NO RPT NOT MEASURES RESTRICTING THE PERSONAL FREEDOM OF CULTURAL WORKERS.

THE RADIO REPORT SAID: (TEXT):

"IN REPLY TO NUMEROUS ENQUIRIES FROM CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS AND FROM ABROAD, CHIEFLY FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF THE P.E.N. CLUB, CONCERNING THE FATE OF SOME CZECHLOVAK WORKERS ON THE CULTURAL FRONT, THE MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR ANNOUNCES THAT THE APPROPRIATE CZECHOSLOVAK AUTHORITIES HAVE TAKEN NO MEASURES WHATEVER BY WHICH THE PERSONAL FREEDOM OF THE WORKERS WOULD HAVE BEEN RESTRICTED.

"AS HAS BEEN ASCERTAINED, THEY ARE WORKING NORMALLY AND PARTICIPATING ACTIVELY IN OUR PUBLIC LIFE."
